Treasurer's Report

£2696 in bank, going down. Last report was 6 months ago. Since then there is a deficit of £648. £533 income, £1181 expenditure (£500 to KidzZone), insurance £300, AGM expenses £140. Income of £400 from Reg Meuross concert. Should we be fundraising or ask for grants from Parish Council? For LCA Diary £240 is available and £ 138 spent, £500 is available for KidzZone. In total, £900 for KidzZone and £600 for Elderly support is available from the Parish Council. In the short term we will draw funds from Parish Council but look to fundraising in the longer term.
