Dominic Holland 29 November 7pm for 7.30 start – Community Hall. Intended to be main fundraiser. Catering by Linda. Fiona needs help - Becky and Nicky offered.

Puck's Bottom 8th February. Essentially a Children's/Family event (5years+). Prices set Children £4, LCA £5, non-LCA £7. Help needed – Nicky happy to help.

8.48 Recycled Teenagers.

Now 36 'members'. £300 support from LCA. Have already been to Milestones Museum, The Lights, Christmas Shopping in Winchester and Trading Standards event in Barton Stacey. 8.50 Trading Standards Event.

Happened in Barton Stacey rather than LP. Some Recycled Teenagers attended. Useful advice and literature about scams and 'cold-callers'. Will discuss at next meeting. In the meantime:

8.51 Choir.

Jeremy reported the intention to donate £40 from Funday to Choir to cover cost of buying music. Agreed.

8.52 Community Hall.

8.53 Party Tent.

Agreed to make available but not to promote for the time-being until researched what is a reasonably generous rental rate. In the meantime welcome donations for use of tent and for Jeremy's time. Erection needs to be supervised. Borrowers need to understand they are liable for damage to the tent (e.g. send email).

Action: Jeremy to help supervise use for John's wedding. Also make available for Village fete.

Action: Christine to find out from County Museum Service about storage containers to keep tent and any other appropriate items of LCA kit.
