10.01: Membership Update

The Membership Secretary reported membership at 192 of which 142 were renewals. FOLS, Parish Council, PPC and Playgroup have joined as affiliate groups.

10.02 : Treasurer's Report

Financial position remains sound. Current balance stands at £7843

In addition the LCA has approximately £200 in stock and £582 in equipment. The equipment figure includes a recognition of depreciation value which it is intended to reduce to zero after 2 years.

Major outgoings have been Kidzone (£601), Recycled Teenagers (£368), Insurance (£312), Equipment (£112), Events Diary insert (£236). AGM costs yet to be taken into account.

The meeting agreed that the LCA should work towards holding a figure nearer £5K rather than the current £7.8K
